RELEASE OF 2023 SINGAPORE-CAMBRIDGE GCE A-LEVEL EXAMINATION RESULTS

1. The release of the 2023 GCE A-Level examination results will take place on 23 February 2024 (Friday) at 2.30pm.
2. Please read the following information which will detail how you will be receiving your results.

Collection of Examination Results

3. If you are well, you may collect your certificates, SGC and college annual (if applicable) in college from 2.30pm on 23 February 2024. You may, however, enter the college from 1.00 pm and register your attendance via the Facial Recognition System (FRS). Do note that accompanying parents/relatives/guardians would need to register at the guard post.
4. Please report to the hall by 2.15 pm for the Principal's address and other administrative announcements. Alternatively, you can also access your results online if you are unable to come to the college.
5. If you are unwell, please do not come to the college. You can access your results online via SEAB Candidates Portal at www.seab.gov.sg from 3.15pm on Friday, 23 February 2024 till 11.59pm on Thursday, 7 March 2024. School candidates who are eligible for Singpass can use their Singpass account to access SEAB's Candidates Portal. School candidates who are International Students will receive their system-generated username via email from Tuesday, 20 February 2024.
6. For those who are unable to come to the college to collect your certificates and who intend to authorize a proxy to collect your certificates on your behalf, please note that he/she can only collect the certificate with a duly completed and signed **Authorisation Form** which can be found in the attachment. Your proxy will have to bring along this form, as well as his/her **identification card** for verification purposes.

Digital Certificate for Application to Local Autonomous Universities

7. Applications for admissions and/or scholarships to the local Autonomous Universities (AUs) can be done online. All school candidates who apply to the local AUs online **do not need** to submit a copy of their A-Level certificates. More information on the AU's admissions processes can be found on their respective websites and applicants can approach the AUs directly for further clarifications.
