RELEASE OF 2024 SINGAPORE-CAMBRIDGE GCE A-LEVEL EXAMINATION RESULTS

- 1. The release of the 2024 GCE A-Level examination results will take place on 21 February 2025 (Friday).
- 2. Please read the following information which will detail how you will be receiving your results.

Collection of Examination Results

- 3. Please report to the hall by 2.00 pm for the Principal's address and other administrative announcements. You may, however, enter the college **from 1.00 pm** and register your attendance via the Facial Recognition System (FRS). Do note that accompanying parents/relatives/guardians would need to register at the guard post.
- 4. If you are unwell, please do not come to the college. You can access your results online via SEAB's Candidates Portal at www.seab.gov.sg from 3.15 pm on 21 February 2025 (Friday) till 11.00 pm on 7 March 2025 (Friday). School candidates who are eligible for SingPass can use their SingPass account to access SEAB's Candidates Portal. School candidates who are International Students will receive their system-generated username via their NYJC email from 19 February 2025 (Wednesday).
- 5. If you are unable to come to the college to collect your results and intend to authorise a proxy to collect them on your behalf, please note that the proxy can only collect the certificates with <u>a duly completed and signed</u> **Authorisation Form**, which can be found in the attachment. Your proxy will have to bring along this form, as well as his/her **identification card** for verification purposes. Your proxy may collect the results and certificates after the Principal's address and the administrative announcements.

Digital Certificate for Application to Local Autonomous Universities (AUs)

6. Applications for admission to the local autonomous universities (AUs) and/or their scholarships can be submitted online. All school candidates who apply to the AUs online **do not** need to submit a copy of their A-Level certificate. More information on the AU's admissions requirements and processes can be found on their respective websites and applicants can approach the AUs directly for further clarifications.
